


“What Lease Packages Are Available?”

The Pickering Horse Centre offers three lease packages. The horse lease options are a great opportunity for students to try leasing for a shorter period of time at a set cost. These leases are offered at a flat rate and are available for a minimum of a three month period.

The show lease option is ideal for riders that want to step into the show ring without the long term commitment and cost of owning their own horse.

All school horses are available for leasing.



Interested in a Lease?

Ask your coach what horse would be suitable for you to lease. Set up a meeting with Danielle or Jennifer to arrange your horse lease.

“What is horse leasing?”

A no risk way of enjoying horse ownership. Different lease packages offer you exclusive use of the horse and equipment for different purposes and durations.

“How will leasing benefit me?”

Leasing a horse will give students more saddle time, to develop and refine their skills, work on improving their equitation and focus on specific goals. As students will be assigned an individual horse there will be a significant opportunity to develop a true partnership.

“Who can lease?”

Leasing is available to all riders that are at the jumping level.

“What are my responsibilities if I lease?”

Students that lease are responsible for exercising their horses, keeping their horses properly groomed and keeping their tack in good care. Coaches will develop a customized exercise and practice schedule with specific rider development objectives in mind.

Leasing a horse allows students to have the full experience of owning a horse and be able to take their riding to the next level, all without the high initial costs or risks of purchasing a horse.

We require 30 days notice from the 1st of the month to indicate intent to discontinue.

Package A: Full School Horse Lease **Available year round**

Riders will have exclusive use of the horse 7 days a week.

Fee: \$1200.00 + HST per month

Package B: Part School Horse Lease **Available October to March**

Riders will have exclusive use of the horse and tack 3 days a week.

Fee: \$600.00 + HST per month

(Students can choose between one lesson a week and two practice rides or two lessons a week and one practice ride)

Package A & B include the following:

- Exclusive use of a specific horse
- Boarding Fee
- Lesson(s) each week
- Feeding, cleaning the stalls, and daily maintenance of the horse
- Farrier (horse shoeing)
- Deworming and vaccinations
- Saddle, bridle and all other tack
- Clipping, mane pulling



Package C: Show Horse Lease **Available year round**

Riders will have exclusive use of a show horse 7 days a week.

Show Horse Lease Fees

Lease: Starts at \$2500.00 (+HST) for a six month period. (Lease fees for show horses vary based on the horse’s ability and show record).

This is a onetime fee that is paid upfront when the contract is signed.

Lease Fee includes the following:

- Lease fee of the horse
- Saddle, bridle and all other tack

Additional costs

Training Board: \$975.00 + HST per month (2 lessons a week, Feeding, cleaning the stalls, and daily maintenance of the horse)

Additional Lessons: \$200.00 + HST per month (includes 4 lessons)

Farrier (horse shoeing): Every 6 weeks and the average cost is between \$100.00 and \$200.00.

Deworming: Every 3 months and the cost is approximately \$35.00.
