RULES AND CONDITIONS

MEMBERSHIPS:

1. Any riders entering classes or divisions at this horse show must be current members in good standing of the Ontario Equestrian Federation (OEF).

ADMINISTRATION:

1. Entries must be received on or before the closing date to avoid post entry fees. Closing date is the MONDAY PRIOR TO ALL SHOW DATES. Entries received after Monday prior to the show date will be assessed a \$20.00 post entry fee.
2. Administration and Stall fees are not refundable. NO EXCEPTIONS. Entry fees will be returned if cancelled in the show office IN WRITING 24 hours before the competition with proper medical documentation. Once the horse has entered the show grounds, there will be no refund unless authorized by show management. No telephone entries or scratches are accepted. Scratched entries providing notification 24 hours in advance without proper medical documentation will be assessed a \$25.00 scratch fee and administration fees, class/division fees will be waived. All unpaid fees will be considered an outstanding account until paid in full. Any classes/divisions entered but not completed will be charged. There will be no refund for classes scratched on the day of competition for any reason. You may change from one class and replace by another, or change from one division to another at no additional charge.
3. All NO SHOW entries, including faxed in entries, will be charged full entry fees and all other applicable fees. All accounts must be settled before the next show, otherwise entries will be denied.
4. A \$50.00 charge will be added to all accounts paid with cheques that are returned for any reason.
5. Show management has the right to change or amend the show schedule the day of.
6. All riders must wear a back number when mounted

GENERAL:

1. Current Equestrian Canada rules will govern all classes.
2. To compete in the under saddle class, the horse must complete at least one course over fences.
3. Any and all visiting dogs must be on a leash at all times.
4. In the event of a fall of horse/and or rider, the competitor must leave the ring dismounted.
5. All riders must wear proper fitted, approved helmets, with safety helmets properly secured at all times while mounted on competition grounds.
6. The show management reserves the right to alter conditions, refuse entries or cancel classes.
7. Exhibitors and or spectators participate at their own risk, and agree not to hold Pickering Horse Centre Ltd., horse show staff, and agents liable for damage to, or loss of property, or injury to persons or animals whatsoever the cause.

POINTS

Champion & reserve champion prizes for all divisions (with a minimum of 5 entries).

Year-end ribbons for all divisions. These will be presented at the final show to the top 6 riders of all Divisions. Points will be tabulated on riders (not horses). Riders must participate in a minimum of 50% of shows where the division is offered. Riders or representative must be present at the Season Finale horse show to receive awards. All divisions open to all ages of riders.
