DIRECTIONS

Please note: Pickering Horse Centre is accessible from Concession #7 only. There is no access from Hwy.7 (due to 407 Construction)

From **Brock Road** proceed north on Brock Rd. to concession 7 (set of lights north of Hwy 7). Turn right (east) on to concession 7 and proceed to Paddock Rd (on right hand side). Turn right (south) on Paddock Rd until you reach 3800 (PHC sign at entrance to parking lot)

From **Westney Road** proceed north on Westney Rd. to concession 7 (stop sign north of Hwy 7). Turn left (west) on to concession 7 and proceed to Paddock Rd (on left hand side). Turn left (south) on Paddock Rd until you reach 3800 (PHC sign at entrance to parking lot)

What are the camp hours? Camp runs from 9:00 a.m. to 3:30 p.m. Early drop off and late pick up is available.

Do I pack a lunch? Campers pack their own lunch. Each camper will be provided with a locker to keep their lunch and personal items in.
